Intent

At Little London our aim in the teaching of Art and Design is to inspire our children to develop their confidence to experiment and invent their own pieces of art. Our curriculum is designed to give pupils every opportunity to develop their ability, nurture their talent and interests, express their ideas about the world, as well as learning about art and artists with different cultures, traditions and throughout history.

Implementation

To support the delivery of our curriculum, we use the Kapow Primary Art and Design scheme. Art is taught as a discrete subject in every year group.

Our curriculum is progressive throughout the whole school and builds on children's prior understanding of taught concepts and skills. We focus on practicing these forms and skills in our sketchbooks, before working on our final piece of work. Units in year groups are organised into 4 core areas of Art and Design:

- 1. Drawing
- 2. Painting and mixed media
- 3. Sculpture and 3D
- Craft and design

The evidence of their work is recorded within the art sketchbook, which follows the children through the school. We take great pride in the outcomes of our children and the corridors are adorned with their wonderful Art work.

SMSC is promoted in Art and Design as we prepare pupils for opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of later life.
