

English

In reading children will be exploring the text, The Wild Way Home. We will also be working on literal retrieval using nonsense, limerick and free verse poems. In writing, the children will be learning the following skills to build-up to writing a portal story:

- Use of direct speech
- Use of descriptive language to create a vivid setting
- Use of various sentence structures with different openers, using commas to mark clauses
- Time for editing and redrafting

Maths

We will follow the White Rose scheme and focus on place value. Children will learn place value for numbers up to 1000 and partition these numbers.

RE

The children will learn about Judaism. In this topic children will learn about the beliefs and practises of Jews and why promises are at the heart of their faith. They will also learn about the celebration of Rosh Hashanah.

Music

The children will be learning to study music from the past, looking at its structure and understand its inspiration.

History

The children will learn about the Stone Age life up until the Bronze Age. They will also learn about how Stone Age people lived, hunted and created art. They will use timelines, including the use of AD/BC and will look at key events, in particular, the progression in farming over the course of the Stone Age to Bronze Age. The children will look at artefacts and resources such as Stone Henge and Skara Brae.

Spellings

Year 3 are focusing heavily on improving their spellings and in the next half term they will be mainly learning:

- Homophones: their, there and they're
- Possessive apostrophes

Computing

In Computing lessons, children will be learning about how to stay safe online and the actions to take in order to stay safe. They will know how to report content that is inappropriate.

Stone Age



PSHE

Children will learn about how to be a good friend. They will also learn about different ways to resolve conflicts in friendships.

French

Children will learn to listen attentively to spoken French and show an understanding of how to respond. They will learn correct intonation and pronunciation. Children will learn specifically to converse. Their topic theme is 'Moi!'.

PE

Both Year 3 classes will be exploring movement in gymnastics and fundamentals.

Science

The children will be learning about plants and how they grow.

- They will be able to name the parts and functions of plants and have fun seeing what happens when water travels through a plant.
- They will identify different types of plants. The children will learn about the function of the roots, stem, petals and seeds.

Art

In Art we will be creating our own cave paintings. We will use mixed media in order to create a textured background. We will use natural resources to create our own paints and create a textured final piece. We will learn how and why Stone Age people created cave art.
