Welcome back and Happy New Year! We hope you all had a restful break over the holidays and are looking forward to the year ahead. We certainly are feeling very happy about the progress the children are making and how settled and happy they are in their classes.

English

In English, we will be learning all about Space and the Moon Landings. The children will learn lots of knowledge through history lessons and our key texts. We will read 'Look Up!' and 'Man on the Moon' to learn about astronauts and what it is like on the moon. The children will write a recount about a day on the moon and we will read our recounts out loud on our Astronaut Day where we will blast off rockets that we have made.



Reading

Your child's book will be changed every **Friday**. Please make sure your child brings in their reading book and reading record to school **every day**, as the children will be read with during school time. Phonics videos will be set on Class Dojo each week. Please watch these and remind children to use special friends, Fred talk and read the word.

Please read with your child at least three times a week and sign the reading record.

Maths

In maths, the children will begin to learn about numbers to 20 and consolidate their knowledge of numbers to 10. Children will learn how to add and subtract numbers to 20 in different ways and using different methods. We will also learn how to double numbers within 20 and use Numicon to support our understanding.

PE

Please come to school wearing the correct PE uniform on your child's PE days. This can be the blue polo top provided with navy shorts or a plain black polo top with black jogging bottoms.
