#### Maths:

# Reading:

All children will have their own reading book chosen at their reading level. We would like you to send your child to school each day with it, along with their reading record. The children will also get to choose a pleasure read from the library each week. Please take good care of all books sent home.

Please make sure that you sign your child's reading record at least 3 times a week in order to have their book changed.

# **Greek Workshop visit:**

We are all very excited about the Greek Workshop visit which will take place on Tuesday 23rd April. This can be paid for via ParentMail.
